



**USSSA SENIOR WOMEN'S WORLD TOURNAMENT 2007
SEPTEMBER 14 – 16**

We invite you to come to the 2007 USSSA Senior Women's World Tournament in Gallatin, Tennessee. This is one of the fastest growing and fun tournaments of the year. The City of Gallatin, Leisure Services Department is the host for this year's tournament.

Format: The USSSA softball program will guarantee at least 4 games in its World Tournament.

Entry: \$400.00 per team. Deadline for entry August 24, 2007

Team Registration Deadline: Friday, August 24th is the deadline for entry forms and fees to be received by your State Director. Teams may confirm they have been entered in to the tournament by checking the USSSA website at ussa.com. If your team is not on the website by Tuesday, September 4th, call you state director immediately. Go to ussa.com for a listing of state directors, their address, email and phone numbers.

State Director Deadline: Monday, August 27th is the deadline for all entry forms and fees to be received by USSSA National Headquarters. State Directors must also enter all teams for their respective states in the World Tournament through the USSSA website with an electronic "Letter of Transmittal." The deadline for submitting the electronic "Letter of Transmittal" will be Monday, August 27th. State Directors must also be sure that each team's frozen qualified roster is entered online at ussa.com.

If you cannot register online at ussa.com, or do not have access the internet, teams can mail entry to: Your team's approved entry form and roster from your state director and the team's entry fee in the amount of \$400.00 in the form of cashier's check or money order and should be made payable to:

Roster: The roster we receive must be signed by your State Director. Failure to comply with this rule will result in your team's suspension from participation in this tournament.

Balls: Your host will provide USSSA approved balls for the tournament.

Player check-in: Please check in at the Civic Center in the USSSA registration room upon arrival on Thursday, September 13 from 1:00 – 8:00 PM. On Friday beginning at 7:30 AM, September 14, players who have not checked in previously, will check in at the park where they play their first game.

- All participants in a Senior World Tournament must have a photo I.D with proof of age, and check-in with tournament officials prior to participating. ***Confirmation of photo ID's for the team roster registration will be done at check-in, so please have photo ID ready.***

Brackets: Schedules will not be mailed out in advance. The games that are scheduled for Friday, September 14 will be available by calling the Gallatin Civic Center at 615-451-5911 to find out when your team is unofficially scheduled to play. Times will be available from 12:00 to 7:30 PM on Wednesday, September 13, 2007.

Managers Meeting: There will be a manager's/official's dinner meeting at 7:00PM on Thursday, September 13th at the Gallatin Civic Center. Two representatives from each team will be permitted to attend this event. All teams will be required to have a representative in attendance. The official schedule and rules of play will be distributed at that time.

Opening Ceremonies: Will begin Friday, September 14th at 8:00 AM at the Triple Creek Park–B Complex, Field #5. **All** teams will participate and should be in full uniform. Teams will line up behind their state flag to be introduced. Tournament play will begin soon after the opening ceremonies are completed.

Admission Fees: No gate fees for players or spectators will be charged for the tournament. There will be a \$5.00 fee for all persons who are non players or coaches to enter socials and dinners.

Tournament Awards: 1st to 4th place team awards, Individual medals for 1st- 4th place, All World Team Awards, All World Manager Award, Best Defensive Player, Best Offensive Player Award, Oldest Player Award.

2. The world Tournament Director is under no obligation to accept an entry that arrived after the bracket is drawn.
3. All teams must be completely uniformed alike when competing in a World Tournament.
4. Any team that submits a bad check for payment of entry fee or motel bills will be subject to disbarment.
5. Any teams destroying property or involved in theft of motel property will be subject to disbarment.
6. My team stands ready to play on Friday night if so scheduled.

RULES OF CONDUCT

It is the purpose of the United States Specialty Sports Association to conduct the best possible Tournaments from all aspects. To achieve this objective the USSSA must have the cooperation of each

player, manager, coach and sponsor. We are guests in the city that the tournament is conducted and nothing should occur that would reflect adversely on your team, players, our host city, or the United States Specialty Sports Association. Therefore, it is required that all teams in the tournament comply with the following rules:

1. Team managers must have full control of their players at all times. This means "on" and "off" the field, course, or court.
2. In case of disputed play or decision, team managers or captains may consult the game officials. The other players and coaches or sponsors are to be kept out of the discussion.
3. Managers, coaches and players are not to fraternize with spectators while participating in an event. At no time will any participants be allowed to smoke while participating in any USSSA event.
4. At no time will participants be allowed to drink or have in their possession any alcoholic beverage while participating in any USSSA event.
5. Managers are to report any unsportsmanlike or derogatory acts by players or spectators to the tournament director. The purpose here is to prevent any serious situation developing that would be harmful to the tournament.
6. Managers, coaches, players, sponsors and teams are liable for suspension by not adhering to the tournament rules in effect. This could mean suspension for a game, games, tournament or a longer duration depending on the act of violation.
7. A player, coach, manager or sponsor may be suspended for fighting, abusive tactics or unbecoming acts that are detrimental and not in the best interest of the United States Specialty Sports Association and tournament play.
8. Be careful of your conduct. Be sure that no action occurs that could reflect adversely on your sponsor, team or division. Remember that the wrong actions of even one player can reflect upon your entire team and the various sporting programs.
9. Any report by the hotel or motel management, where any team competing in USSSA championship play is staying, of destruction of property or abuse of hotel or motel property will be dealt with very sternly. Team managers and sponsors will not be warned other than through this notice. Failure to pay hotel or motel bills can result in team disbarment from future USSSA play.
10. Any teams submitting bad checks to the USSSA will be subject to disbarment.
