

# State At-Large Berths For USSSA World Tournaments

## STATE AT-LARGE BERTH SYSTEM FOR MEN'S CLASS B, C, & D SLOW PITCH WORLD TOURNAMENTS

Slow Pitch World Berths will be awarded to the highest ranked team from each state and to the State Tournament Champion

Tournament National Point System used by the National Office shall be the only authorized Point System.

All Tournament Reports must be submitted to National Headquarters by August 27th in order for the teams to receive their points.

Team must have the highest number of points after the completion of their State Tournament be the State Tournament champion.

Teams qualifying must have a minimum of 200 points after the State Tournament. Teams qualifying must have participated in a minimum of one (1) National Invitational Tournament (NIT) during the season.

Teams qualifying must have participated in a minimum of six (6) USSSA sanctioned events including NIT's and State Tournaments (**National Ranking point berth only**).

Teams receiving their berth through the State berth system will not receive travel money and must provide \$300 entry fee into the World Tournament.

The berth may drop to the next highest ranked team in the state or the next highest finisher in the state championship if the team meets all of the listed criteria.

All berths must be approved and issued by the team's Slow Pitch State Director and the appropriate Vice-President or Executive Vice-President and accepted by National Headquarters by August 27th.
