The entry fee for the double elimination tournament will be \$300.00. Only money order, certified check, or USSSA Director's check will be accepted. Make check payable to USSSA.

### **ENTRY PROCEDURE FOR STATE DIRECTORS AND NATIONAL TOURNAMENT DIRECTORS**

All entry forms (and entry fees, if applicable), must be received at USSSA Headquarters by Wednesday, September 12th. Send to: USSSA National Office, Attn. Marsha Brewer, 611 Line Drive, Kissimmee, Fl 34744. State Directors must also confirm the entries of all teams from their respective states into this World Tournament through the USSSA website with an electronic "Letter of Transmittal." State Directors must also be sure that each team's frozen and approved roster is entered online at [ussa.com](http://ussa.com). **THIS IS MANDATORY!**

### **TOURNAMENT ENTRY CONFIRMATION**

Teams may confirm they have been entered into the tournament by checking the USSSA website at [ussa.com](http://ussa.com). If your team is not on the website by Monday, September 17<sup>th</sup> at 3 PM EST, **CALL YOUR STATE DIRECTOR IMMEDIATELY.**

Roster changes may only be made in accordance with USSSA eligibility rules in the Official USSSA By-Laws. Contact your State Director for assistance. **PLEASE DO NOT CALL THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR OR USSSA NATIONAL HEADQUARTERS REGARDING ROSTER CHANGES!!!** Your frozen, qualified roster must be posted on [ussa.com](http://ussa.com).

*All players participating in USSSA tournament play shall have photo ID available in accordance with the USSSA Rule Book to be applied. The offending team loses the game, is ejected from the tournament, placed last in the standings and forfeits all awards, sponsors travel money and tournament berths that would have been awarded at the tournament.*

**ALL PLAYERS and COACHES MUST SIGN the *Disney's Wide World of Sports® Waiver Form*. You can find the waiver form at [usssa.com](http://usssa.com). Having the waivers filled out will streamline your team's check-in time.**

All teams must be available to play Saturday morning September 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2007. **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

There will be a manager's meeting at 4:00 pm on Friday, September 21<sup>st</sup> at the *Disney's Wide World of Sports®Complex*. All teams are required to have a representative in attendance. The official schedule for teams playing will be distributed at that time.

3. All teams must be completely uniformed alike when competing in a World Tournament.
4. Any team that submits a bad check for payment of entry fee or motel bills will be subject to disbarment.
5. Any teams destroying property or involved in theft of motel property will be subject to disbarment.
