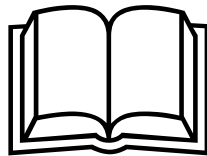

Congratulations on an outstanding season and welcome to the 2007 USSSA Men's Over 35 and Over 40 Major and Super Major Masters World Tournaments. The tournaments will be played at the Connecticut Sportsplex - 150 Foxon Rd – North Branford, CT the weekend of October 12th thru the 14th.

Both tournaments will use the "Double Elimination" format. Over 40 teams will be able to play in both World Tournaments. The Over 40 will begin play on Friday October 12, 2007 and end early afternoon on Saturday October 13, 2007. The Over 35 World Tournament will commence early afternoon on Saturday October 13, 2007 and finish early afternoon on Sunday October 14, 2007.

THE ROSTER WE RECEIVE MUST BE SIGNED BY YOUR STATE DIRECTOR OR POSTED AT www.ussa.com, AND APPROVED BY YOUR STATE DIRECTOR. THIS ROSTER MUST BE THE ONE THAT WAS SUBMITTED TO YOUR STATE AND/OR AREA DIRECTOR WHEN YOUR TEAM QUALIFIED FOR THIS TOURNAMENT. FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THIS RULE WILL RESULT IN YOUR TEAM'S SUSPENSION FROM PARTICIPATION IN THIS TOURNAMENT! ADDITIONAL RULES AND INFORMATION FOR THE MASTERS PROGRAM CAN BE FOUND ON USSA.COM.

Your team's World Tournament entry form and cashier's check or money order for the entry fee MUST BE RECEIVED BY YOUR STATE DIRECTOR BY OCTOBER 1, 2007 and then forwarded to tournament headquarters by October 8, 2007 to guarantee your spot in the tournament. Your entry fee, in the amount of \$300.00 should be payable to: USSSA. For a listing of state directors, their addresses, e-mail, phone numbers, etc. go to www.ussa.com Teams must go through their state director and may not directly enter either of these World Tournaments.

All players participating in adult USSSA tournament play shall have a photo ID available. Failure to do so will result in Rule 4, Section 11-5 in the USSSA Rule Book to be applied. The offending team loses the game, is ejected from the tournament, placed last in the standings and forfeits all awards, sponsors travel money and tournament berths that would have been awarded at the tournament.

Bracket schedules **WILL NOT** be mailed out in advance. You may check the website at www.ussa.com on October 10th after 6PM to find out when your team is unofficially scheduled to play beginning October 12, 2007. 40 And Over teams must be prepared to play Friday night.

Your World Tournament host will provide USSSA approved softballs for the entire championship.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All teams participating in the Masters World Tournament must wear alike colored jerseys. Non-duplicating numbers on all jerseys are required. The numbers must be a minimum of three inches in size and clearly visible.

COURTESY RUNNERS

Only one courtesy runner per inning may be used. The courtesy runner will be the last recorded out. If it is the first inning and there are no outs, the courtesy runner will be the player in the last position of the batting order.

HOME RUNS

For Both the Over 35 and Over 40

Super Major-Seven home runs per team per game

Major-Three home runs per team per game

PARK ADMISSION

Admission for non-players will be \$6.00 per person per day or \$10.00 for a tournament pass. Players and team coaches must pay the standard \$2.00 Complex admission fee. USSSA Directors in possession of their Directors cards will incur no admission fee.

TOURNAMENT SPONSORS

The Mens Over 35 Major and Super Major World Tournament will be sponsored by Team Mattingly. The Mens Over 40 Major and Super Major World Tournament will be Sponsored by Mizuno. Balls will be provided by Dudley Sports. Also the Greater New Haven Visitors & Convention Bureau is the Major sponsor of this event.



RULES OF CONDUCT



It is the purpose of the United States Specialty Sports Association to conduct the best possible Tournaments from all aspects. To achieve this objective the USSSA must have the cooperation of each player, manager, coach and sponsor.

We are guests in the city that the tournament is conducting and nothing should occur that would reflect adversely on your team, players, our host city, or the United States Specialty Sports Association. Therefore, it is required that all teams in the tournament comply with the following rules:

1. Team managers must have full control of their respective players at all times. This means "on" and "off" the field, course, or court.

2. In case of disputed play or decision, team managers or captains may consult with the game officials. The other players and coaches or sponsors are to be kept out of the discussion.

3. Managers, coaches and players are not to fraternize with spectators while participating in an event. At no time will any participants be allowed to smoke while participating in any USSSA event.

4. At no time will participants be allowed to drink or have in their possession any alcoholic beverage while participating in any USSSA event.

5. Managers are to report any unsportsmanlike or derogatory acts by players or spectators to the tournament director. The purpose here is to prevent any serious situation developing that would be harmful to the tournament.

6. Managers, coaches, players, sponsors and teams are liable for suspension by not adhering to the tournament rules in effect. This could mean suspension for a game, games, tournament or a longer duration depending on the act of violation.

7. A player, coach, manager or sponsor may be suspended for fighting, abusive tactics or unbecoming acts that are detrimental and not in the best interest of the United States Specialty Sports Association and tournament play.

8. Be careful of your conduct. Be sure that no action occurs that could reflect adversely on your sponsor, team or division. Remember that the wrong actions of even one player can reflect upon your entire team and the various sporting programs.

9. Any report by the hotel or motel management, where any team competing in USSSA championship play is staying, of destruction of property or abuse of hotel or motel property will be dealt with very sternly. Team managers and sponsors will not be warned other than through the notice. Failure to pay hotel or motel bills can result in team disbarment from future USSSA play.

10. Any team submitting bad checks to the USSSA will be subject to disbarment.

MASTERS PROGRAM - RULES

Eligibility & Valid Proof

Age Requirements Men's 35+ Masters Division – player must turn 35 years old by 12/31/2007. Men's 40+ Masters Division – player must reach 40th birthday by 12/31/2007. All participants in a Men's Over 35 and Over 40 Master's World Tournament must have a photo ID, with proof of age, and check in prior to their teams first game.

Uniform Rule

Non-duplicating numbers are required on all Teams' uniform jerseys at the Masters 35 & 40 World Tournament. The numbers must be a minimum of 3 inches in size and clearly visible. Jerseys and pants and/or shorts must be similar in color. If hats are worn they must be similar.

Courtesy Runners

A. In the Men's Over 35 & Over 40 only one courtesy Runner per inning may be used. The courtesy Runner will be the last recorded out. If it is the first inning and there are no outs, the courtesy Runner will be the Player in the last position of the batting order.

Divisions of Play and Home Run Rule

A. The Men's Masters 35 and 40 over programs will have two Divisions of play, Major and Super Major. The Super Major will be allowed seven (7) Home Runs and the Major Division will have three (3) Home Run limit. Any Home Run in excess of the limit allowed will be ruled a dead ball out.

Men's Masters Roster Rule:

Men's Masters 35 & 40 Major teams must be bordering states and but can have one player from a non-bordering state; Super Major teams have no residency requirements.

Starting A Game & Substitutions: The Game may start with 9 Players; however, an out shall be declared when the tenth position in the lineup is scheduled to bat. A tenth Player may be added in the tenth position anytime before the end of the Game. A Team that starts with 10 or 11 players may drop to a minimum of 9 Players to finish a Game. All vacant spot(s) in the lineup will be declared an out every time that lineup position is due to bat. If a Player is ejected from the Game for any reason the Team must have a substitute available to replace the ejected Player or the Team will forfeit the Game. If a Team starts with 9 or 10 Players they are not allowed to add the eleventh at a later time.

Run Rule & Flip Flop Rule:

A team shall be awarded a win, by the Run Rule, if they are ahead by 25 runs after three innings, 20 runs after four innings or 15 runs after five or more complete innings. The Flip Flop rule will be in effect for the entire tournament.

Entry Forms will be returned, as unaccepted, to teams that fail to follow this procedure. 2. The World Tournament Director is under no obligation to accept an entry that arrived after the bracket is drawn. 3. Jerseys and pants or shorts must be similar in color. 4. Any team that submits a bad check for payment of entry fee or motel bills will be subject to disbarment. 5. Any teams destroying property or involved in theft of motel property will be subject to disbarment. 6. My team stands ready to play on Friday Night if so scheduled. I agree with above code of understanding. Release I, the undersigned, manager of the team shown on this entry form hereby state that the team represented by its roster, is a voluntary participant in this tournament which is sanctioned by the United States Specialty Sports Association (USSSA). In consideration of this acceptance of our application to participate in said tournament we do hereby release and forever discharge USSSA of and from all liabilities, claims, actions and possible causes of action whatsoever that may accrue to us or to our heirs from every and any loss and injury including death that may be sustained by our person or property while, in about, or route into and away from said tournament.
