A 220-acre, state-of-the-art facility where amateurs to professionals, kids to seniors, and serious athletes to recreational sports enthusiasts will have an opportunity to experience the exhilarating fun of sports competition.

SPECTATOR ADMISSION: All spectators are required to purchase admission into ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex by either an individual daily admission or length-of-event (LOE) pass that is valid for all days of the team's stay. LOE and general admission tickets are non-refundable/non-exchangeable, regardless of number of days your team competes. If you purchase an individual daily admission from an offsite facility, you may turn it in at the box office at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex for credit towards your purchase of a length of event ticket. You may only turn in 1 offsite ticket towards the purchase of 1 length of event ticket.

SEATING/SHADE: Each of the Diamonds had permanent bench style seats. Teams may bring in their own tents & chairs, provided that they do not interfere with the field of play or stake into the ground.

PARKING: Parking is \$5 per day per vehicle at ESPN Wide World of Sports Complex. Grass parking, when available, is complimentary. Guests must walk from the parking lot to the entrance of the complex. There are no trams.

POLICIES:

- **FLUIDS:** Water stations will be located in each team dugout area.
- **COOLERS:** Individual 1 gallon coolers and a team 5 gallon cooler are permitted. However, alcoholic beverages and glass containers are NOT permitted. (Please be aware that these rules may be different at the various off-site facilities.)
- **LOCKER/STORAGE:** There is no storage for team equipment at the venues. All teams should keep their equipment with them at all times.
- **EQUIPMENT DROP OFF:** Teams may drop off their equipment at the designated equipment area near the bus drop-off zone and load onto an equipment pargo. One team member will escort the equipment to the "drop off area" at your designated field location. The service is a courtesy to our guests, but does not have to be utilized. First come, first serve as the pargos run continuously throughout competition hours.
- **CONCESSION STANDS:** Teams & spectators will find concession stands conveniently located throughout our property.

- No pets allowed inside the park.
- No standing on park benches or other foreign objects such as tables, step ladders, chairs or other items that can pose harm to themselves or those around them.
- No smoking on the fields, in the buildings or in the dugouts.
- All carry-in containers are subject to inspection.
